I do hereby Certify that Math'w Block Enlisted in the 2<sup>d</sup> Vir. St Reg. prior to Mar 77 for the term of three years, that when the Reg't. marched to the North'd. in 78 he was left behind on Comm'd. & that he served the term for which he engaged & was disch'd.
