The Deposition of William Marshall being first duly Sworn Deposeth and Sayeth that Stepen Bloxom that was a Seaman on bord of the Galley Accomac [sic: *Accomack*] Commanded By Capt. underhill [William Underhill VAS2457] died Intestate

Sworn to before me this 24 day of Nov'r 1832

I also Certify that I was well acquainted with the above Stepen Bloxom and he Dec'd Intestate
