



This may certify that Thomas Adams inlisted a Soldier in Capt James Mason's Company [raised in Brunswick County VA] of the 15<sup>th</sup> Virginia Continental Regiment in the Month of December in the year 1776 to serve three years – which Soldier died in the Service of the United States. Given under my Hand this 27<sup>th</sup> day of October 1796.
