Virginia, Accomack county, Feb'y 29 1820

I do hereby certify, that Elijah Boston inlisted in the 9th Virginia regiment, on continental establishment, the latter end of the year 1775, or the begining of the year 1776, and that he served faithfully until the end of the war, when he was regularly discharged.
