I do certify that James Bowen did serve as a Soldier in the Virginia Line from the 22nd of December 1776 to the last of November 1780 when he was discharg'd by Lord Stirling [William Alexander] and that he is of Course entitled to the Bounty of Land granted by the State to Soldiers who serv'd 3 years or upwards.

Given this 4th of January 1784.
