Philip Bowers late a matross in Capt. Singleton [Anthony Singleton [BLWt2068-300] company in the first Reg't of continental Artillery commanded by Colo. Charles Harrison [VAS1411] having served the term for which he stood engaged Is hereby discharged the service of the United States his good Behaviour as a Soldier entitles him to the respect & esteem of all his countrymen

Given under my hand at the Park of Art. near Morristown this sixth day of Feb'y 1780.
