I do certify that Francis Boykin of the County of Isle of Wight entered into the service of the United States in the first Virginia Reg't Commanded by Patrick Henry in the Company Commanded by Wm. Davies [William Davies BLWt597-500], that he served in the same Regiment in the Northern States & behaved as a good officer, that I saw him in the year 1780 under th command[?] of Gen'l. Muhlenberg [Peter Muhlenberg BLWt1495-850] in this state with the advance of the army then Commanded by the Marquis de la Fayette [Lafayette], I think in the Character of Major. Given under my hand in Isle of Wight County the 19th of Feb'y 1808
