

Richmond 6<sup>th</sup> May 1784

I do Certify that John Branham inlisted as a Sergeant in the first Virginia Continental Regiment the 22<sup>nd</sup> August 1780 & Served in that Capacity untill about the middle of April 1781, when he then reinlisted in the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment of light Dragoons agreable to Gen'l Orders  
Arch'd Denholm [Archibald Denholm]
