

The affidavit of Spencer Clarke [Spencer Clark (Clarke) W2529] of Middlesex County and State of Virginia aged seventy

This affiant being duly sworn according to law states upon Oath that he was well acquainted Alexander Bristow of Middlesex county that the said Bristow was a regular soldier in the revolutionary war and served a regular tour to the north under Capt. Webb three years

And futher this affiant sayeth not Sworn to and subscribed this 9th day of April 1834
