I Certify that Edward Broadus a private in the Second Virginia Regiment Reenlisted to serve in the Second Virginia Reg't three years from the 26 Decem'r[?] 1776 and died at a Hospital near Morris Town [Morristown NJ] in the summer following, and I have always Understood that James Broadus Serj't was his Eldest Brother

Cert iss'd 4<sup>th</sup> Jan 85

At a Court held for Culpeper County April 19[?] 1784 James Brodus proved to the Court by the Oath of Richard Gaines and Joseph Gaines that he is heir at Law to Edward Broadus, who died in Continental Service which is Ordered to be Certified.
