

Virginia, Accomack county, Feb'y 26 1820.

I do hereby certify, that James Brodwatter in the 67th year of his age, was born in the said county, that he inlisted a midshipman on board the Accomack Galley, June 1778, and that he was discharged in June 1779; that he discharged his duty faithfully, as I have been informed and believe; and that the said Galley was in the state service of Virginia, and was commanded by Capt. Wm. Underhill [William Underhill VAS2457].
