State of Kentucky Franklin County Set

Henry Brock this day personally appeared before me John Walker A Justice of the peace for said county and made oath that he Inlisted in Virginia in the year 1776 for three years inn the Six Virginia Regiment on Continental line in Capt Oliver Towles [BLWt2213-450] Company Commanded by Col Mordica Buckner [sic: Mordecai Buckner] and was discharged at the Valaye Forge [sic: Valley Forge] in Pennsylvania by Col Charles Simms and that he continued to serve in said service untill said Inlistment was expired at which time he was honourably discharged as above and through the course of time he has lost his discharge or it has been misslaid and he has never received his land warrant for his services Sworn and subscribed to before me

And I certify that the said Henry Brock is a credible witness on oath Given under my hand this

State of Kentucky Shelby County to wit

This day [7 Oct 1824] John Mullikin [S35529] personally appeared before me John Wells A Justice of the Peace for the County aforesaid and made oath that he has long been acquainted with Henry Brock who has subscribed to the fore going affidavit and that he well knows that he is the Identical person he therein represents himself to be and further knows that he did perform the military services therein stated and that the said Henry Brock was appointed quarter master Sergeant while he was in said service and was Discharged Quarter Master Sergeant
