The two documents transcribed below are almost entirely illegible, and a third, apparently consisting of accounts, was not legible enough to attempt transcribing.]

I Certify [several illegible words] the Virg'a Line on Continental Establishm't [several illegible words] & has been in Actual service untill this date [the rest illegible; probably signed by Lt. Ballard Smith of the infantry attached to the 3rd Regiment of Continental Light Dragoons (see <http://revwarapps.org/b137.pdf>)]

I hereby Certify that John Brockus Soldier in the Virg'a line and in Continental Service from March[?] 1779 [one or two undeciphered words] 1783. Certified under my hand this [the rest illegible; the index card says that one document was signed by Joseph Conway.]
