

York Town Jan'y 27th 1783

This may Certify that Doct'r Lodowick Brodie continued in the actual service of the State from
the 15th 1778 'till the 2^d Aug't 1782

A handwritten signature in cursive script, reading "Chas Dabney". The signature is written in dark ink on a light background. Below the signature, there are some faint, illegible markings that appear to be a date or a reference number, possibly "1782".

NOTE: According to Heitman's *Historical Register of Officers of the Continental Army During the War of the Revolution*, Brodie's service as a Surgeon began on 15 Aug 1778.
