Whereas James Brooks formerly Soldier in my Company has informed me, “that on account of the Term of his service being omitted in his Discharge, he cannot Obtain a Warrant for the Lands due him for his Military Services”: These are therefore to certify that the said Brooks was enlisted for, and served the term of three years in the Virginia Continental Forces, and was discharged in April 80 at Charlestown [Charleston SC]
