

I do hereby certify that Nath'l Brooks a Soldier in Colo. Russells [William Russell BLWt1849-500] Detachment of the Virg. Line has served the full term of 3 years for which he was Inlisted and is now hereby Discharged from the service – that he has received his pay in Cont Currency up to the 1st Decem. 1779 since which time he has only received two Dollars Specie from the Commissary of Prisoners in Charles Town [Charleston SC].

Given under my hand this 26 day July 1781 at Wms'burg [Williamsburg VA]

I do Certify that Nathaniel Brooks inlisted as a Soldier in the first Virginia Continental Regiment sometime in the month of September 1777 for the term of three years, which term he served in the said Regiment. Given under my hand this 13th March 1783.
