



I do Certify that John Brown an Inveled [invalid?] Continental Soldier of the Virg. Line was Receiv'd by me the 4<sup>th</sup> of May 1782 to do duty in the Laboratory by order of the late Commissioner of War, in which service he Continued to this day, & being no longer wanted, is hereby discharg'd till call'd on by proper Authority.

Given Under my hand this 10<sup>th</sup> day of September 1783
