

I do Certify that Rob't Brown Inlisted in the 10<sup>th</sup> V Reg't the 10<sup>th</sup> of Oct'r 1776 for the term of three years  
and discharged the 29<sup>th</sup> June 1778 on Account of a wound he Rec'd in the Service

Given Under my hand at Richmond this [?]<sup>th</sup> day of Cecem'r 1783

J Brown Lt 1<sup>st</sup> V.R.
