



The affidavit of Carter Croxton [S9250] of the County of Essex and State of Virginia, aged Seventy three Years.

This affiant being duly sworn according to law states upon oath, that he is now Seventy three Years of age, and that he was well acquainted with Aaron Bull, who was a resident of the County of Essex. that the said Bull enlisted in the United States service in the revolutionary war, some time in the Year 1776, under Capt. Seayres[?], as well as he now recollects) in the Continental line, for three Years which time of enlistment he served fully out and further this affiant saith not. Sworn and subscribed this 18th day of March 1834 Carter Croxton Sen'r
