I hereby Certify William Burfoot a Soldier in the 10th Virginia Regiment enlisted into the service of the United States the 8 day of Jan'y 1777 for the term of three years and having served the full term of his enlistment is now discharged from the Service and Commissarys on the road are required to furnish him with provision til he get home provided he makes no unnecessary delay.

Given under my hand at Fredrickburg Town [Fredericksburg VA] the 26 day Jan'y 1780.
