Richmond 8<sup>th</sup> March 85


I Certify that Thomas Burns Joind Colo Campbells [William Campbell W4149] detachment as a private soldier some time in the Month of September 1780

Arch'd Denholm [Archibald Denholm]

A handwritten signature in cursive script, reading "Arch'd Denholm". The signature is written in dark ink on a light background.

The above T. Burns is Mustered on the Roll of Cap. Rudulph [Michael Rudulph BLWt945-300] Company of Lt. Col. Lees [Henry Lee] Legion April 1<sup>st</sup> 1782 as for the war – but Invalid.

Arch Denholm

NOTE: From the time of Burns's entering service under Col. William Campbell it would appear that he may have been in the battle of Kings Mountain, 7 Oct 1780.
