I certify that I was well acquainted with Jeremiah Cake who entered the army of the Revolution in the Continental Line in the Capacity of a private in the year 1779 and that he served out the balance of the War and was honorably discharged but I do not now recollect the name of the Capt under whom he served as witness [my] hand and seal this 26th day of June 1832
