

I do certify that Major Callihan Matross served three years in Colo Charles Harrison [Charles Harrison VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery, and was legally discharged at Hillsborough [sic: Hillsborough] North Carolina the 30<sup>th</sup> day of Oct by me

Richmond 19<sup>th</sup> Feb'y 1784
