


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters


I Certify that Lawrence D Camp was a Soldier under my Command in the thirteenth Virginia Regiment and served three years & was Discharged by Col. Gipson [sic: John Gibson S41578
April [rest illegible] David Scott [S25425]
