King and Queen County Court October 14<sup>th</sup> 1811

Moses Nunn produced a certificate signed H. Young [Henry Young BLW2466-300] Capt'n and made oath that he is the person to whom it was given and that he has never before proved or claimed his right to Land for the service in the said Certificate mentioned
