This is to Certify that William Canary formerly a Soldier in Regim't having duely & Faithfully served more than the term of three years for which he was enlisted is in Consideration thereof and at his own request discharg'd from any further service in the said Reg't. he having rec'd all his pay Bounty Cloathing & Defecency of pay & Cloathing in full of all allowances or provision made by Congress.

Given under my hand at Camp near Wmburg [Williamsburg] this 6 Day of July 1781.
