
I do Certify that the division that I belonged to in King & Queen in the time of the... George Carlton son of Richard Carlton... that he saw the said... he must expire in a very short time Given under my hand this 17 day March...

King & Queen County

August [rest undeciphered]

At the request of Richard Carlton [undeciphered word] of a certain George Carlton I hereby Certify that said Geourge [several undeciphered words] to General Mulenburg [Peter Muhlenberg] as a [undeciphered word] from this County about the last of September 1780 to serve (I think) during the [one or two undeciphered words] to the best of my recollection [one or two undeciphered words] said Richard [undeciphered word] some years ago a Certificate of his said Land [one or two undeciphered words] which is more to be depended on than this certificate as to the time he inlisted for – [several undeciphered words] last part of the [undeciphered word] for the service delivered Sept'r 1780.
