I Certifie that William Carlton was a Soldier in the first Virginia Reg't that he faithfully discharged the duty of a Soldier for the term of his enlistment which was from the 4<sup>th</sup> of August 1776 to the 4<sup>th</sup> Aug't 1779 that he was then discharged by Gen'l Muhlenburg [sic: Peter Muhlenberg BLWt1495-850] agreeable to the mode of discharging soldiers which discharge I believe he lost in the southern army, then a Soldier in Major Nelsons [John Nelson W5414] Cavalery.
