THESE are to CERTIFY that the bearer hereof Jeremiah Carmine a private in the first Reg't of Light Dragoons Commanded by Col George Baylor, having faithfully served the United States from the 10th day of February 1781 and being inlisted for the war, is hereby discharged from the American army.

Given at the war office the 10th Da of March 1784

By order of the secretary at war, B. Lincoln

THE within CERTIFICATE shall not avail the bearer of a discharge, until the ratification of the definitive treaty of peace; previous to which time, and until proclamation thereof shall be made, he is to be considered as being on furlough.
