I do certifie that Samuel Carr was a Lieutenant in Capt'n Thomas Walkers company, at the time that company join'd the 9<sup>th</sup> Virg'a regiment, which was in the summer 1776; shortly afterwards he the said Carr was appoint'd Capt'n of marines on board the Brigantine Northampton Capt'n Francis Bright [R16]; not long after his appointm't to be Captain of marines I understood he died in that service. Given under my hand at Richmond 4<sup>th</sup> November 1790. Jno Cropper Jr.
