At a Court held for King and Queen County at the Courthouse on Monday the 13<sup>th</sup> of May 1833  
I Alexander Shackelford [S7506] of the County of King and Queen an old Soldier of the  
Revolution was well acquainted with William Kidd and Henry Batcheldor of the County of Middlesex  
[undeciphered word] and know that they did enlist under Captain Charles Collier in the first Virginia State  
Regiment and did serve as soldiers under Captain [sic: Colonel] George Gibson [BLWt1985-500] from  
February 1777 till the year 1780
