I hereby Certify that John Dancer Reuben Brown & James Bush Dec'd inlisted with me about the month of Dec'r one thousand seven hundred & seventy six for three year's or during the War, & served in the first Virg'a State Reg't Unitll (to the best of my recollection) some time in the year one thousand seven hundred & seventy eight & died in Service. Given Under my hand this 26th Sept'r 1795.
