Thos. Chewning late a Matross in Capt Benjamin [undeciphered] Company in the first Regiment of Artillery Commanded by Col Charles Harrison having served the term for which he [undeciphered] engaged is hereby Dischargd the service of the United states his behaviour as a Souldier entitled him to the Respect and Esteem of all his Cuntry – given under my hand near Morris Town [Morristown NJ] 20 Day feby 1780
