This is to Certify that James Chizham inlisted a Soldier Jan'y 2nd 1777 to serve in the 10th Virginia Continental Regiment for the Term of Three years & that the said Chizham Dec'd [deceased] March 1778.

Thomas Fox [BLWt765-300] Capt.

21st April 1784.

NOTE: The rolls of Capt. John Spotswood's company of the 10th Virginia Regiment list James Chizham, also spelled James Chesham, in the hospital for many months during 1777 and 1778. On the roll for March 1778 "Jas. Chizham" is listed with the remark "Eras'd Out."
