I hereby certify that Sampson Clark listed a private Centinel in a Company in which I was an Ensign about the Month of Feb'y or March in the year One thousand seven hundred & seventy six which Company was Join'd to the fourth Virginia Reg't commanded by Colo. Adam Stephens [sic: Adam Stephen] The said Clark died in that service sometime in the Winter following. Given under my hand this 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1808
