November 23 1805. I do Hereby certify that Presley Cockrel, Robert Throckmorton and John Hill served as Soldiers in the first Regiment Light Dragoons during the late revolution, and were inlisted for 3 years, or during the war, and that the Two first mentioned served out their time and the last died in the service.

Given under my hand and seal the day and year above written.

I do certify that Presly Cockrel enlisted in the 1<sup>st</sup> Reg't. of Dragoons the fourth day of June one thousand seven hundred & seventy Eight for three years, which time he served faithfully & that he has rece'd no Pay since the 1<sup>st</sup> of Feb'y 1780. Given under my hand this 23<sup>rd</sup> day of June 1783
