Richmond th27 May 1783

I do Certify that the Bearer John Cogay was Discharged the 22 day of august 1780 & was a private in the State artillery Com'd by Colo thomas Marshall as witness my hand

A handwritten signature in cursive script, appearing to read "G. Johnson".

Sir pleas to let Mr James Cawthon draw my Land warrant for being a State Soldier & you will Oblige
To Mr. Mariweather [sic: Thomas Meriwether]

A handwritten signature in cursive script, appearing to read "John Cogay".

The bearer John Cogay a Soldier in Colo. Marshalls reg't of State
Artillery having served three years the term for which he was ingaged for is hereby discharged
Given under my hand at Richmond the 30th May 1783
