At a Court held for James City County Sept'r 11th 1786

A Certificate from Colo. J. Allison [John Allison W4112] of James Colden having served three years as a Soldier in the first Virginia State Regiment, And another Certificate from Robert Andrews a Justice of the said County of the said Soldier's having made Oath before him, of his never before proving or claiming his Right to Land for the Service aforesaid, were produced & read & ordered to be certified & recorded
