This is to Certify that Thomas Collier (son of Jas. Collier Cobler) served three years in the Second Virginia Regiment as a Soldier

Given under my Hands this 21 day of April 1813 John hisXmark Collier

This is to Certify that Thomas Collier (son of Jno. Collier Crump) inlisted for three years as a Sergant in the Second Virginia Regiment and the said Collier died in the Service. Given from under our Hands this 31 day of May 1813 George Isam

[King and Queen County]
