


Southern Campaign American Revolution Pension Statements and Rosters

State of Tennessee } This day personally appeared Samuel Colquitt, before me John Jones, one of the  
Franklin County } Justices of the peace in and for the said County and made oath in due form of law  
that he was an Enlisted Soldier for during the war – served in the Sixth Regiment of Virginia attacht to  
Capt. Thomas Paterson’s Company [Thomas Patterson, company raised in Buckingham County] who he  
served under untill the Close of the War – the time of Enlistment not recollected but was discharged  
October 1783.
