King Wm County to Wit

Thomas Lipscomb came before me a Justice of the peace for the county aforesaid, and made oath that Thomas Comer inlisted in the seventh Regiment some time about the year 1776 and served in the said Regim't for the term of three years. Given under my hand this 2<sup>d</sup> day of January 1813.
