The Bearer William Jackson Conner a Soldier in the 3rd Virg^a Battalion having faithfully Served three years it being the Term for which he was Inlisted in the Continental Army is hereby discharged

Dane[?] at Charleston on this 17th Ap^{'l} 1780 [see endnote]

Wm Woodford Brig^{'dr} Gen^{'l} [Willaim Woodford]

A handwritten signature in black ink, appearing to read "Wm Woodford", written in a cursive style.

No Warrant issued to William J. Conner
Feb'y 11 1808 Wm Price Reg'r

NOTE: At the time of the discharge Charleston SC was under siege. It is likely that Conner was made prisoner along with the other Continental troops on 12 May 1780.
