

Brunswick County June 2<sup>d</sup> 1784

I do certify that Edward Crews inlisted as a Soldier in the 4<sup>th</sup> Virg'a Continental Reg't the 2<sup>d</sup> day of Sept  
1776 for three years, after which servitude was discharg'd [illegible] day Sept'r 1779

Jno. Stith then Capt [John Stith BLWt2064-300]  
4<sup>th</sup> V. Reg't.
