

Henry Crook Came before me one of the Justices of the peace for the County of Washington in the State of Virginia and made Oath that he is the Same Henry Crook Whom the Secretery at war directed to be placed on the list of Inroled Pensioners in Virginia and that He Served in the year 1780 in the State Rigmment of Mariland in Captain Archibald Goldirs [Archibald Golden?] Company Who was commanded by Collonal Adams [Peter Adams BLWt372-450] who was Commander of the Said Rigmment at the time he was disabled. That He now Resides in the County of Washington and State of Virginia and has Resided there for the last Thirty years & previous to which he Resided in the County of Frederick in the state of Mariland Given under my hand and Seal this 13th day of April 1818. 
I Henry Crook of the County of Washington and State of Virginia do here by constitute and appoint James Preston [James Patton Preston] Governor of the State of Virginia My Lawful Attorney to Receive in my behalf of Thomas Nelson Commissioner of [undeciphered word] in Virginia My pension for Eighteen Months Viz. from the 4th of September 1816 to the 4th March 1818. Given under my hand this 13th day of April 1818 Henry crook



I Henry Crook of the County of Washington and State of Virginia do hereby constitute and appoint James Preston Governor of the State of Virginia My Lawful Attorney to Receive My additional Pension allowed me by an act of the General Assembly of Virginia, Passed the 10th day of February 1817, viz the sum of Sixty Dollars which agreeable to the above Recited Act becomes Due the 10th day of February 1818. Given under My hand this 13th Day of April 1818.



I Henry Crook of the County of Washington State of Virginia do hereby constitute and appoint Collonal David Campbell of Washington county State of Virginia My Lawful Attorney to Receive in my behalf My Increase of pension of Sixty Dollars of the Auditor of the state of Virginia (or the Person Duly Authorised to pay the same) which was granted to me by an act of the General Assembly made bearing date the 10th day of February 1817 in the State of Virginia at Richmond to be paid Annuley Given under my hand this 16th day of September 1818.



I Chreschany Crook widow and executrix of Henry Crook dec'd late of Washington County Virginia do constitute and appoint Peter Mayo Gent. my lawful attorney for me and in my behalf to receive from the proper Officer the pension to which my said husband was entitled under and Act of Assembly of Virginia, from the time to which the last payment was made, which is believed to have been to the 10th day of August 1818 up to the 18th day of March 1819 being the day of his death. Given under my hand this 19th day of October 1819.

1820 Jan'y 4 Received a Warrant for thirty six dollars thirty four Cents. Peter Mayo

NOTE: Henry Crook was given a disability pension by the federal government, but the file in his case contains no information about his service or how he was injured.
