Be it known unto all to whome these presents shall come that on this seventh day of September in the year of our lord Eighteen hundred and Eleven personally came before me the Under sined a justice of the peace in and for said county John A Shaw [VAS3193] and being duly Sworn as the law directs this deponant deposeth and sayeth that Thomas Shaw Served as a pilate [sic: pilot, i.e. guide] to the armey Under the command of General Clarke [sic: George Rogers Clark VAS269] in his Expedition in the year Seventeen hundred and Eighty two a gainst the indians and further this deponant sayeth not Sworn and Subscribed before me this day and year first above written
