Be it known Unto all to Whome these presents Shall come that on this Seventh day of September in the year of our lord Eighteen hundred and Eleven personally came before me, the Under-sined a Justice of the peace in and for said county Aaron Atherenton and being Duly sworn as the law Directs this Depnant Deposeth and Sayeth that John A Shaw living in the indianna [sic: Indiana] Territory and now in the presents of this Deponant says that the said John A Shaw served as a private Soldier a tower in Captain Ventrees's [possibly John Vartreese] companey Under General Clark [George Rogers Clark VAS269] in the year Seventeen hundred and Eighty two a gainst the indians and further this deponant sayeth not sworn and subscribed before me this day and year first above written
