Frederick Town Jan'y 21st 1780

Henry Dewit a Soldier in the 8th Virginia Regiment belonging to the Army of the United States of America having served three year's being the time of his enlistment is therefore discharged from the Service.

Be it knone unto all whome the same doth or may Concern that on this fourteenth day of October in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and Eleven before me John Buck A Justice of the Peace in and for said County Personaly Came John Bray [sic?] who being duly sworn A Cording to Law he deposeth and saith that Henry Dewit deceast his heirs Living in harden County State of Kentuckey say that the said henry Dewit serv'd as A privet soldier in Captain Wm. Vauses [William Vause] Company under General George washington in the years of seventeen hundred and seventy five seventy six and seventy seven against the British and farther this deponent saith Not Sworn and Subscribed the day and date A Bov
