I do hereby Certify that Samuel Cross served three years in Colo. Harrisons [Charles Harrison VAS1411]
Regim't of Artillery and was Disch'd the 10th day of Jan'y 1780 and that the said Cross was & is still an
Inhabitant of Virginia D. Ragsdale Capt. [Drury Ragsdale BLWt1854-300]
