I Certify that John Watkins enlisted and was appointed a Sergt in the 4th Virginia Regiment of Continental Troops the 26th day of January 1777. was appointed Quarter Masters Serjt. the first day of Jan'y 1778. he served the term of his enlistm't & was discharged the 28th day of January 1780

Given under my hand this the 23^d day of Decem'r 1783

NB he rec'd his pay up to the 1st Dec'r 1779
since that time he has rec'd no pay from the Regt
