

I do Certify that James Davis a Soldier late of Colo. Nevill's [John Nevill BLWt1595-500] detachment of the Virginia Line has served the full term of three years for which he was engaged and is now hereby discharged from the Service. That he has Recieved his pay in continental currency up to the first day of december one thousand seven hundred & seventy nine since which he has only rec'd two dollars in specie sent by Congress to the prisoners at Charlestown [Charleston SC surrendered 12 May 1780]

Given under my hand at Richmond this second day of September 1781
